Contract Amendment #6 Habitat for Humanity Tucson, Inc

Recommendation and Summary:

Staff requests placement of this contract amendment on the next available Board of Supervisor (Board) Agenda (or Addendum if necessary). The amendment provides for a no cost, one-year contract term extension. The original contract was approved by the Board of Supervisors in May 2010 providing for NSP2 activities. Funding Purpose:

This agreement, no cost, term extension, provides for Habitat for Humanity to continue to reinvest program income that they have retained.

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The goal of the NSP program is the stabilization and revitalization of neighborhoods impacted by the housing bust and recession. Habitat for Humanity is constructing homes in the two Copper Vista subdivisions in southern Tucson.

Public Benefit:

Stabilization of a low income neighborhood, and increasing homeownership for low income families.

Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Habitat for Humanity builds and sells approximately 20 homes each year.
