In reviewing agenda item 9, I am shockingly reminded that the current BOS is not working in my best interest.

- County federal lobbyists shall advocate for the County's access to federal dollars and to make and enforce rules and regulations to support critical infrastructure and local programs and efforts to avoid street release in support of the federal response to the passage of legal asylum seekers through Pima County.
- Illegal Immigration does not support tax payer services.
- Support severe orders of protection ("red flag laws") and all measures to promote the safe use of firearms and reduce unintentional injuries and suicide due to firearms.
- Red Flag laws are a great way to get someone convicted without any proof of wrongdoing. That does not support lawful citizens.
- Protect the public health authority. "It is proposed that Pima County oppose any effort to limit the ability to respond to public health emergencies appropriately."
- We saw the harm caused by no limit to what health officials can do. Why would we (citizens) want more of that?
- Oppose requirements to use E-Verify Enrollment in Public Welfare Programs
- Again you are giving away our benefit of living in the USA and being a citizen to illegals and non citizens and it is costing us in all areas. Health services, housing costs, detention costs, food cost, public garbage costs, poor roads, etc.
- BoS Grijalva is asking for proposed amendments in the legislative lobbying, including:
- > Allow local jurisdictions to adopt requirements for firearms sales.
- > Allow local jurisdictions to limit housing rent increases.
- > Allow local jurisdictions to adopt inclusionary zoning policies.
