Agenda Item #9: Pima County Climate Action Update

Agenda Item #21: Grants Management and Innovation - Tucson Medical Center (TMC), Amendment No. 1, to provide for TMC emergency room enhancements and amend contractual language, American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, contract amount \$180,000.00

Our Recommendation: We do not support digitizing and consolidating every aspect of our lives for the benefit of the government. The Pima County Board of Supervisors has misused ARPA funding. This COVID funding has essentially been used to help weaponize hospitals by bolstering electronic data and surveillance.

Agenda Item #24: Award - Amendment of Award: Supplier Contract No. SC2400000969, Amendment No. 10 ...

Our Recommendation: Pima County should be out of the vaccine business. Why are you spending \$1,000,000 MORE tax dollars on jobs. Please confirm whether or not these are mRNA jobs. Are COVID jobs actually safe and effective -- we know they DO NOT WORK. You will never push another job, another mask, another lockdown, another mandate, or close businesses on individuals, no matter how much you try to intimidate the public.
