I would like to just weigh in on the agenda item regarding our sheriff.

It is very important to me that our sheriff be directly accountable to the voters.

The voters should be the only ones to remove him, or replace him, unless the conduct is extremely egregious. In my opinion the level of conduct does not reach that standard.

Because the sheriff is elected, he has been much more responsive and forthcoming than other law enforcement officials we have tried to reach out to with the community protection task force. Those other officials have since engaged, but it seemed clear to me that the responsiveness of the sheriff was directly related to his being accountable directly to the voters. Please keep it that way. It is not appropriate to remove him via a board action.

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
