Arizona Center for Autism (dba The Abbie School) purchased the property at 360 S. DeValle Avenue, Tucson, AZ, 85711 (Parcel 128-01-016E) as part of the property purchase of Parcel 128-01-016G, in January of 2021.

The property is currently owned and operated by the Arizona Center for Autism (dba The Abbie School) as a private, nonprofit school for autistic and neurodevelopmentally challenged children.

Dear Board of Supervisors:

Arizona Center for Autism (dba The Abbie School) currently owns the property located at 360 S. Del Valle, Tucson, 85711 (parcel # 128-06-016E. We operate as a private, non-profit school for children with autism and are an IRS recognized 501 (c) 3. Our school serves neurodevelopmentally challenged children ages 5-22 in grades from Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Our property consists of two parcels of land; parcel #128-06-016G located at 5870 E. 14th Street, and parcel # 128-06-016G located at 360 E. Del Valle Ave in Tucson.

In October of 2021, we submitted our application and were granted a property tax exemption for the parcel located at 5870 E. 14th street (see attached). When we received a subsequent tax bill, we assumed it was for the same property however, it was not. The tax bill was for the property located at 360 E. Del Valle Avenue. We thought we needed to submit another waiver with the assessor's office. We did so on 4/20/2022 for the property tax bill we received in the amount of \$1,702.24, but we inadvertently listed the parcel number for the 5870 E. 14th street location (128-06-016G) instead of the parcel number for 360 E. Del Valle Street (128-06-016E). Due to this mix up, we were not granted a tax exemption for the property and are now being assessed past due real estate taxes in the amount of \$1,702.24.

I spoke with the assessor's office, and they suggested that I complete the request for waiver and affidavit for organizational tax exemption for the 360 E. Del Valle property (128-06-016E) and submit it. In addition, they suggested I reach out to the Board of Supervisors, who would be the only entity that could only grant a tax exemption in the amount of \$1,702.24 for the 2021 tax year.

I am respectfully asking the Board of Supervisors to kindly grant this request. We are a nonprofit school, and the tax bill would create a burden on our organization.



I have attached to this letter all the documents sent to the assessor's office along with a copy of the past due real estate bill for the property at 360 E. Del Valle Avenue (parcel 128-06-016E). If there is any other information needed or if anyone has any questions, I will provide the Board with whatever documentation is needed.





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Bylaws

ARTICLE I

CORPORATION, NAME, AND PRINCIPAL OFFICE

- **1.1 Name.** The name of the corporation (henceforth referenced the "organization" shall be known as Arizona Center for Autism (dba, The Abbie School). The organization was incorporated with the Arizona Corporation Commission on November 22, 2011. The Arizona Center for Autism is an IRS, federally recognized non-profit corporation. The EIN is 45-4094834.
- **1.2 Principal Office.** The principal office of the Organization shall be in its known place of business located at 5870 E. 14th Street, Tucson, AZ, 85711.
- **1.3 Statutory Agent.** The Arizona Center for Autism (dba, The Abbie School), shall have and continuously maintain a registered agent as required by the state of Arizona. The Registered/Statutory Agent may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors.
- **1.4 Corporate Seal.** A corporate seal shall not be requisite to the validity of any instrument executed by or on behalf of the corporation.
- **1.5 Fiscal Year.** The fiscal year of the organization shall begin the 1st day of July, and end on the 30th of June each year.
- 1.6 Books and Records. The organization shall keep correct and complete books and records of account. The corporation shall maintain and have available for public inspection its Application for Recognition of Tax Exemption and Determination Letter as provided by federal tax laws.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

- **2.1 Charitable Purpose.** The purpose for which the organization is formed is set forth in the Articles of Incorporation, which include providing educational services and behavioral intervention as it applies to children with autism.
- **2.2 Dividends Prohibited.** The organization is not formed for pecuniary or financial gain, and no part of the assets, income or profit is distributable to, or will inure to the benefit of, its directors, officers, or other private individuals; provided, however, that nothing contained herein shall be construed to prevent the payment of reasonable compensation for services actually rendered by employees, directors, or officers of the corporation and reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection therewith.

ARTICLE III MEMBERS

The Organization shall have no members.

ARTICLE IV BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- **4.1 Number, Role, Size and Composition.** The Board of Directors shall consist of no less than (3) members. The board is responsible for overall policy and direction of the organization, and delegates responsibility of the day-to-day operations to the Head of School/Director. The Directors shall determine at any annual or regular meeting, by majority vote, the number of members of the Board of Directors. Each Director shall hold office until their term expires, or until their death, or until their resignation or removal in the manner hereinafter provided.
- **4.2 Qualifications.** The organization shall strive for representation that reflects the organizations constituents and the community it serves. In addition, board members should value diversity and understand the role of participation and inclusion.
- **4.3 Terms.** All board members shall serve two-year terms. Each director is eligible to serve three (3) consecutive terms, for a total of six (6) years. A Director who

has served three consecutive terms shall not be eligible for re-election until one year after the expiration of such Director's final term.

- **4.4 Compensation.** The board receives no compensation other than reimbursement for reasonable expenses.
- **4.5 Election of Directors.** Directors (including those whose terms have expired) shall be elected by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
- **4.6 Vacancies.** Any vacancy occurring by reason of resignation, removal, death etc., may be filled by an affirmative vote of a majority of the remaining Directors then in office, though not less than a quorum, or by a sole remaining Director. A Director elected to fill a vacancy shall serve for the balance of the predecessor's term.
- **4.7 Resignation.** Any Director may resign at any time by filing a written resignation with the Board Chair/President.
- **4.8 Removal.** Any Director may be removed by a two-thirds vote (2/3) of the total board of directors present at a regular or annual meeting.
- **4.9 Unexcused Absences.** Three (3) unexcused absences in one (1) year shall be grounds for removal of the board.

4.10 Notice of Meetings:

A. Regular, & Annual Meetings-Each Director shall receive written notice of each annual and regular meeting at least seven (7) days prior to such meeting.

Regular Meetings-Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at least quarterly at such place and time as decided by the Board. One meeting shall be designated as the annual meeting.

Annual Meetings-Shall be held at such time and place as fixed by the Directors for the purpose of electing Directors, Officers and other such business.

- **B. Special Meetings**-Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by the President or upon written request to the Secretary, signed by at least one-fourth (¼) of the Directors.
- **4.11 Quorum and Voting**. A quorum of the Board of Directors consists of a majority of the number of Directors in office immediately before the meeting begins. Each Director shall have one vote. The act of the majority present at a

meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors. Voting by Proxy shall not be allowed.

- **4.12 Meeting Participation by Electronic Means.** The Board of Directors may permit any Director to participate in a regular or special meeting by, or conduct the meeting through the use of, any means of communication by which all Directors participating may hear each other during a meeting. A Director participating in a meeting by this method is deemed to be "present" in person for the meeting.
- **4.13 Action Without Meeting.** Actions may be taken without a meeting pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes 10-3821. Further, telephonic meetings are allowed pursuant to the Arizona Statutes.

ARTICLE V OFFICERS, POWERS, ELECTIONS, TERMS

- **5.1 Officers.** The Officers of the Organization shall be at minimum, a President (Board Chair), Secretary and Treasurer. At no time may the office of President and Treasurer be held by the same person.
- **5.2 Election and Term of Office.** The Officers of the Organization shall be members of the Board of Directors and shall be elected by the Board at its annual meeting or at such time when the terms of the Officers are set to expire. Vacancies may be filled or new offices created and filled at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Each Officer shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Board of Directors and until their successor has been duly elected and deemed qualified.

5.3 Powers.

- A. President-The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors. The President shall sign all deeds and conveyances, all contracts and agreements, and other instruments requiring execution on behalf of the Organization (Corporation), and shall act as operating and directing the head of the Organization, subject to the policies established by the Board of Directors.
- **B. Secretary-** The Secretary shall see that the minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors are recorded, voted on by the board at the subsequent meeting, and

signed appropriately by the President and Secretary. The Secretary will give notice of all meetings to the Board of Directors and shall have charge of all the books and records of the Organization. The Secretary is responsible for authenticating records of the Organization as requested or required by law.

C. Treasurer-The Treasurer shall have general custody of all the funds of the Organization except as such as may be required by law. The Treasurer shall see to the deposit of funds of the corporation in financial institutions as the Board of Directors may designate. Regular books of account shall be kept under his or her direction and supervision, and shall render or provide financial statements to the President and Board of Directors at proper times. They shall have charge of the preparation and filing of reports, financial statements and returns as required by law.

The Treasurer may delegate certain administrative duties to the Director/Head of School if this position is filled and with authorization of the Board of Directors.

- **5.4 Elections.** Any vacancy of any office for whatever reason may be filled for the un-expired portion of the term by the Board of Directors at any meeting.
- **5.5 Removal.** Any Officer may be removed by a vote by the Board of Directors at any time, with or without cause.
- **5.6 Terms.** The Officers of the Organization shall be elected by the Board at its annual meeting or at such time when the terms of the Officers are set to expire. Vacancies may be filled or new offices created at any meeting of the Board of Directors. Each Officer shall hold office until the next annual meeting and until their successor has been duly elected.

Terms for Officers shall be two years, beginning immediately after an election. Any Director elected to an office shall be limited to two consecutive terms.

5.7 Executive Director (Director, Head of School). The Board of Directors by resolution, shall appoint a Head of School (Director) as the Board deems appropriate. The Head of School shall, subject to the President and Board of Directors, supervise and manage the day-to-day operations of the school. The Head of School shall perform all duties incident to this office, and any other duties as required by these Bylaws or prescribed by the President or Board of Directors. In the absence of a School Director, the President shall be responsible for supervising and managing the school affairs, or appoint an appropriate substitute, as approved by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI COMMITTEES

- **6.1 Committees.** The Board, by resolution adopted by a majority of the entire Board may designate one or more Directors to constitute various committees as it deems necessary. Each such committee shall have and may exercise such powers as the Board may determine and specify in the respective resolutions appointing them. In no event shall any committee exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in reference to acts prohibited under A.R.S. 10-3825. A committee shall fix its own rules of procedure and time and date of its meeting.
- **6.2 Executive Committee.** The Board of Directors may by resolution designate its Officers plus any additional Board members or Committee Chairs as it sees fit to constitute an Executive Committee. The Executive Committee shall have the powers and authority to act on behalf of the Board in the management of business and affairs of the Organization, as needed, in between board meetings. The Executive Committee shall keep regular minutes of its proceedings and report its actions to the Board at the next regular meeting. And, when approved, said actions shall become the actions of the Board of Directors.

The Executive Committee shall not have the power to reverse the actions of the Board, amend or repeal the Bylaws, or expend any funds not in accordance with the Organizations approved budget. By a majority vote of the Board of Directors, the Board may at any time, revoke or modify any or all of the authority delegated to the Executive Committee, and increase/decrease the number of Officers/Board members serving on the Committee.

- **6.2 Quorum.** Unless otherwise provided in the resolution of the Board of Directors designating a Committee, the Committee Chair and two members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum.
- **6.3 Minutes.** Each Committee shall keep and provide minutes to the Board of Directors.
- **6.4 Rules.** Each Committee may adopt its own rules for governance consistent with these bylaws.
- **6.5 Compensation.** No member shall receive compensation for services.
- **6.6 Dissolution of Committees.** The Board, by resolution adopted by a majority of Board, may with or without cause, dissolve any committee.

6.7 Vacancies. In the event a vacancy on a committee may occur, the Committee Chair shall notify the Board President and the Board shall fill the vacancy, if it deems necessary, by a majority vote at the next meeting. This process shall be followed in the event of a Committee Chair vacancy as well.

ARTICLE VII ADVISORY COUNCILS

The Organization may establish Advisory Councils as deemed appropriate to further the mission of Arizona Center for Autism (dba Abbie School). Advisory Councils shall be a vehicle to gain advice and assistance form persons with a specific knowledge or skill, or persons of influence or stature in the community to help foster support for the programs of the school.

ARTICLE VIII CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DEPOSITS AND FUNDS

- **8.1 CHECKS, DRAFTS, INDEBTEDNESS.** All checks, drafts, or other orders for payment of money, notes, or other evidences of indebtedness, issued in the name of or payable to the Corporation, shall be signed or endorsed by such person or persons and in such manner as shall be determined from time to time by resolution of the Board of Directors. In the absence of such determination by the Board of Directors, such instruments may be signed by either the President or the Treasurer of the Corporation.
- **8.2 CONTRACTS, OTHER INSTRUMENTS -HOW EXECUTED.** The Board of Directors, except as in these Bylaws otherwise provided, may authorize any Officer or Officers, or agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances. Unless so authorized by the Board of Directors, no Officer, agent, or employee shall have any power or authority to bind the Corporation by any contract or engagement or to pledge its credit or to render it liable for any purpose or for any amount.

- **8.3 Gifts/Grants.** The Board of Directors may accept on behalf of the Organization any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for general purposes or special purposes, in accordance with the fiscal policies and procedures of the Organization.
- **8.4 Loans.** Only the Board of Directors may apply for Loans.

ARTICLE IX BOOKS AND RECORDS

The Organization Shall keep correct and complete books and records of accounts and also shall keep minutes of the proceedings of its Board of Directors and Committees having the authority of the Board of Directors at its principal or registered office. It shall also keep a record of the names and addresses of the Board Members entitled to vote. All books and records of the Organization may be inspected by any member, agent or attorney for such member for any proper purpose authorized by these Bylaws or required by law.

ARTICLE X CONFLICTS OF INTEREST, CONFIDENTIALITY AND FIDUCIARY DUTIES

- 10.1 Conflicts of Interest. No Director or Officer of the Organization shall engage in any course of conduct which may result in a conflict of interest with the Arizona Center for Autism (dba Abbie School). Conflicts of interest shall be governed by Arizona Revised Statutes 10-3860. Each Board Member and Officer shall be required to sign the Conflict-of-Interest Policy annually. The COI policy shall be kept with other Board records such as meeting minutes, Federal Tax Returns (990) etc. that are to be made available to the Public for inspection.
- **10.2 Confidentiality.** Each Director or Officer of the Board will be required to review and sign a Confidentiality Policy for the Organization as it relates to Client records, Duty of Loyalty, Non-Disclosure etc.
- **10.2 Fiduciary Obligations.** Any Board of Director member or Officer may not take advantage of a business opportunity in which the Director or Officer knows that Arizona Center for Autism (dba Abbie School) has a genuine interest and where such an opportunity would be inconsistent with the Organizations mission,

purpose and goals. This includes solicitation to any Abbie School staff member or parent/guardian of Abbie School students.

10.3 Lobbying. Under the IRC, "no substantial part" of the Corporations activities may constitute carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. This same rationale prohibits involvement in political campaign activities and electioneering to which The Arizona Center for Autism (dba Abbie School) are subject.

ARTICLE XI INDEMINFICATION

Unless otherwise prohibited by law, the Organization may indemnify any Director or Officer or any former Director or Officer, and may by resolution of the Board of Directors, indemnify any employee, against any and all expenses and liabilities incurred by them in connection with any claim, action, suit, or proceeding to which they have been made a party by reason of being a Director, Officer, or Employee. However, there shall be no indemnification in relation to matters as to which they shall be judged guilty of a criminal offense or liable to the Corporation for damages arising out of their own gross negligence in the performance of a duty to the Corporation.

Amounts paid in indemnification of expenses and liabilities may include, but shall not be limited to, counsel fees and other fees; costs and disbursements; and judgements, fines, and penalties against, and amounts paid in settlement by, such Director, Officer or Employee. The Corporation may advance expenses or, where appropriate, may itself undertake the defense of any Director, Officer or Employee. However, such Director, Officer or Employee shall repay such expenses if it should be ultimately determined that he or she is not entitled to indemnification under this Article.

ARTICLE XII AMMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new Bylaws may be adopted by a two-thirds majority of the member of the Board of Directors present and voting at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors. Proposed

amendments to the Bylaws shall be sent to the Board of Directors no less than thirty (30) days prior to the meeting at which the amendments are to be considered.

ARTICLE XIII USE OF OUTSIDE EXPERTS

The Organization may, but need not, use outside advisors. If outside experts are needed, their use shall not relieve the Governing Board of its responsibility for oversight and ensuring periodic reviews are conducted.

ARTICLE IX NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

The Arizona Center for Autism (dba The Abbie School), admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sexual orientation, gender/gender identity, national and ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, athletic or other school-administered programs. The Abbie School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, age, physical or mental disability, sex/gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, military status, veteran status, genetic information, pregnancy, pregnancy-related conditions, marital status, socioeconomic status, homelessness, or any other category protected under applicable law in admission or access, or any other aspect of the educational programs and activities that The Abbie School operates.

ARTICLE X WHISTLEBLOWER POLICY

This Whistleblower Protection Policy applies to all of the Organization's staff, whether full-time, part-time, or temporary employees, to all volunteers, to all who provide contract services, and to all officers and directors, each of whom shall be entitled to protection.

Application and Rights

The Whistleblower Protection Policy applies to all of the Organization's staff, whether full-time, part-time or temporary employees, to all volunteers, to all who provide contract services, and to all officers and directors, each of whom shall be entitled to protection ("Protected Persons").

A Protected Person has the right to report, without suffering retaliation, any activity by Arizona Center for Autism (dba The Abbie School), or any of our employees that the employee reasonably believes: 1) violates any state or federal law; 2) violates or amounts to noncompliance with a state or federal rule or regulation; or 3) violates fiduciary responsibilities by Arizona Center for Autism or it's Governing Board. In addition, Protected Persons can refuse to participate in an activity that would result in a violation of state or federal statutes, or a violation or noncompliance with a state or federal rule or regulation.

Protected Persons are also protected from retaliation for having exercised any of these rights in any former employment.

The whistleblower protection laws do not entitle employees to violate a confidential privilege of Arizona Center for Autism (such as the attorney-client privilege) or improperly disclose trade-secret information.

Where to Report

Protected Persons have the duty to comply with all applicable laws and to assist Arizona Center for Autism (dba The Abbie School) to ensure legal compliance. An individual who suspects a problem with legal compliance is

required to report the situation(s) to the Head of School or President of the Board of Directors if the complaint involves the Head of School. Protected Persons may also report information regarding possible unlawful activity to an appropriate government or law enforcement agency.

Protection from Retaliation

It is the intent of this policy to encourage Protected Persons to report fraudulent or illegal activities and there shall be no retaliation for any reports made pursuant to this policy. Any Protected Person who believes they have been retaliated against for whistle blowing may file a complaint with either the Executive Director or the Board President. Any complaint of retaliation will be promptly investigated and remedial action taken when warranted. This protection from retaliation is not intended to prohibit managers or supervisors from taking action, including disciplinary action, in the ordinary course of business based on valid performance-related factors.

ARTICLE X DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. Any assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located. Disposal shall be made exclusively for exempt or public purposes, or be made to such organization or organizations as the court shall determine to be organized exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE XI DEFINITIONS

- I. As used in these Bylaws, unless the context otherwise requires, the following terms shall have the meanings set forth below:
- II. "Articles" shall mean the Articles of Incorporation, as filed with the Arizona Secretary of State's office, (as the same is amended corrected or restated from time to time).
- III. "Bylaws" shall mean this document, as amended from time to time, which is the code or codes of rules adopted.
- IV. "Code" shall mean the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time.
- V. CORPORATION IS A SCHOOL. The Corporation is sometimes referred to in these Bylaws as the "School", in recognition of the principal nonprofit private school purpose for which it was organized.
- VI. "Organization" shall mean the nonprofit corporation incorporated by the Articles and formed under these Bylaws pursuant to the Act. (Also "School").
- VII. "Director" shall mean a natural person serving on the Board of Directors, whether designated in the Articles or Bylaws or elected by the incorporators, and their successors and a natural person elected or appointed by the Members and given the title "Directors", or any other name or title, to act as a member of the Board.
- VIII. "Individual" shall mean a natural person.
- IX. "Officers" shall mean collectively, the President, the Secretary, the Treasurer, and each other Officer if any, elected by the Board of Directors to run the day-to-day operations of the Council.
- X. "Principal Office" shall mean the office located in the state of Arizona as so designated by the Federal Tax Returns or Annual Report.
- XI. "Property" shall mean all property, real or personal, tangible or intangible, including money and any legal or equitable interest owned by the Organization.
- XII. "Regulations" shall mean the Income Tax Regulations, including Temporary Regulations, promulgated under the Code, as such regulations may be amended from time-to-time.
- XIII. "State" shall mean the State of Arizona.






