
Dear Pima County Supervisors:

The Oro Valley Police Department (OVPD) is in support of Operation Stonegarden's grant funding requested by the Pima County Sheriff's Department (PCSD). Many of the consequential crimes resulting from the lack of border security dispenses throughout the state of Arizona. Stonegarden allows us as local law enforcement to investigate and enforce the illegal activity that enters and surrounds our Town. In addition, it allows multiple agencies to increase coordination and collaboration with each other to keep our communities safer.

Since 2010, OVPD has participated in Operation Stonegarden. Oro Valley has a main corridor from Tucson to Phoenix on Route 77. It is an alternative route from Interstate 10.
