Title: Temporary Road Closure Resolution

Introduction/Background:

The Perimeter Bicycling Association of America has requested the temporary closure of portions of Swan Road between Sunrise Drive and Fort Lowell Road for the annual El Tour De Tucson on Saturday, November 19, 2016 from 7:30 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Discussion:

As a result of the Pima County Traffic Engineering Division's traffic control plan review, road closures, including potential detour route if needed due to inclement weather or other circumstances, are recommended to facilitate the event.

Conclusion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends the temporary closure of portions of Swan Road between Sunrise Drive and Fort Lowell Road to enhance the safety of the El Tour De Tucson event by reducing potential vehicular conflicts.

Recommendation:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends approval of this resolution to temporarily close a portion of Swan Road for the El Tour De Tucson on November 19, 2016 from 7:30 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.
