PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, National Voter Registration Day since 2012 has been a national holiday on the fourth Tuesday of September to celebrate our democracy; and

WHEREAS, National Voter Registration Day is a day of civic unity and an opportunity to set aside differences and honor the voting rights and privileges we have in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Pima County, Mi Familia Vota, the One Arizona Coalition, the League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson, the YWCA Southern Arizona, the Tucson Urban League and the Interdenominational Ministerial Alliance, among others, support the informed and active engagement in democracy that voting represents; and

WHEREAS, Pima County and the civic organizations encourage everyone to register to vote, and to help family, friends and neighbors to register to vote; and

WHEREAS, an objective of Pima County and the civic organizations is to ensure that everyone registered gets involved civically for the good of our shared democracy and in elections to follow; and

WHEREAS, Pima County and the civic organizations encourage media and social media outlets to educate Pima County residents about the importance of registering and voting and to inform them about how and where to enjoy these democratic privileges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the day of September 19, 2023, to be:

"VOTER REGISTRATION DAY IN PIMA COUNTY"
