ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Pima County currently prohibits the importation of out-of-county waste at its solid waste facilities. This prohibition was necessary in the past to preserve sufficient landfill capacity for Pima County residents. The County's landfills at Tangerine and Sahuarita are nearing the end of their useful lives and alternative municipal waste disposal locations will be needed. The Tangerine and Sahuarita Landfills will close. It is likely that waste currently being accepted at Tangerine will be taken to the Marana Regional Landfill, a new privately owned and operated landfill expected to open this fall. A transfer station will be constructed and operated at the Sahuarita Landfill. Waste from the transfer station will be taken to a municipal waste facility for final disposal. Since the preservation of county-owned landfill capacity is no longer an issue with the upcoming closure of the landfills, the out-of-county waste prohibition is no longer needed.
