Proclamation to the Town of Marana for the TOWN OF MARANA'S HISTORIC 40TH ANNIVERSARY YEAR



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the town of Marana incorporated on March 21, 1977, and is celebrating 40 years since incorporation; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana began with 1,500 residents and 10 square miles to its current size of 43,750 residents and 126 square miles; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana has grown from an early establishment of mining, farming and ranching families to an agricultural center producing primarily cotton, wheat, barley, alfalfa, and was a center for military power at the Marana Airfield during World War II when it became known as the largest pilot-training center in the world; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana spurred economic development in Pima County, expanding from a gas station and a couple of fast food restaurants on Cortaro Farms Road east of I-10 to the highly successful 70-acre retail power center on the west side of Cortaro and I-10 at Arizona Pavilions, with a theater, large retail stores, grocery stores, banks, and multiple restaurants located near the housing developments in Continental Ranch, Continental Reserve, Hartman Vistas, Cortaro Ranch, and Willow Ridge; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana continues to add value and variety to Pima County through the opening of the Premium Outlet Mall conveniently located along I-10 on Twin Peaks Road; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana attracted the Ritz-Carlton at Dove Mountain, a world class hotel and golf resort development, which hosted the PGA Tour's WGC-Accenture Match Play Championship event; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana has helped expand the educational opportunities for Pima County residents with sixteen schools in the Marana Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the town of Marana has added to the cultural enrichment and entertainment opportunities of Pima County residents with its annual *July 4 Star-Spangled Spectacular* in the Arizona Pavilions where more than 15,000 people turn out for the fireworks show, eat at restaurants and stay in hotels in the area; its *Holiday Tree Lighting* with over 5,000 attendees; and its annual *Founders' Day* event and parade celebrating the history and diversity of the founding of Marana.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the year of 2017 to be:

"TOWN OF MARANA'S HISTORIC 40TH ANNIVERSARY YEAR"

FURTHER, be it proclaimed that all residents, friends and supporters of this town are
encouraged to participate and join in this year's festivities.
