# HIV CARE AND SERVICES

Effective September 20, 2013, it is mutually agreed that the Intergovernmental Agreement referenced is amended as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Page Two (2), Terms and Conditions, Provision Four (4), Contract Administration and Operation, Item (4.12), Scrutinized Businesses, is deleted in its entirety.
- 2. Pursuant to Page Six (6), Terms and Conditions, Provision Six (6), Contract Changes, Item (6.1), Amendments, Purchase Orders and Change Orders, the Scope of Services, Provision Six (6), Deliverables, of the Contract, is hereby revised to add the following:

#### 6. Deliverables

6.5 When an audit is conducted, the Contractor shall be responsible for reimbursing unallowable expenses if an outcome is found for unallowable expenses on a Contractor's Expenditure Report. ADHS will collect any reimbursements due to unallowable expenditures.

# 6.6 Invoices

- 6.6.1 Contractors have 45 days from the receipt of this amendment to provide Part B with a plan on how the agency will ensure invoices/claims are paid within the current grant year.
- 6.6.2 Invoices which are being paid, must be for services received within the current grant year April 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup> Contractors have until May 15<sup>th</sup> to reconcile any payments which are received for the previous grant year. Any invoice received after May 15<sup>th</sup> for the previous grant year cannot be paid with RW grant funds.
- 6.6.3 <u>Example:</u> Current grant year is April 1, 2013 to March 31, 2014. Any invoices with a date of service prior to March 31, 2013 cannot be paid with current grant funds; there are no exceptions. The date of invoice cannot be used; contractors must use the date of service to determine if an invoice can be paid. A contractor who pays for an invoice dated from a previous grant cycle will be required to reimburse ADHS.
- 3. Pursuant to Page Twelve (12), Terms and Conditions, Provision Twenty (20) is added as follows:

### 20. Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) Number Requirement

Pursuant to 2 CFR 25.100 *et seq.*, no entity (defined as a Governmental organization, which is a State, local government, or Indian tribe; foreign public entity; domestic or foreign nonprofit organization; domestic or foreign for-profit organization; or Federal agency, but only as a subrecipient under an award or subaward to a non-Federal entity) may receive a subaward from ADHS unless the entity provides its DUNS Number to ADHS.
