**WHEREAS**, disparities in health outcomes persist among Black and Latinx communities, particularly impacting the well-being of young women and girls; and

**WHEREAS**, research on health-related issues specific to Black and Brown girls is lacking, yet the reality of significant health disparities within these communities cannot be ignored; and

**WHEREAS**, the COVID-19 pandemic has exacerbated existing health disparities, disproportionately affecting Black and Latinx communities and highlighting the urgent need for targeted support and resources; and

**WHEREAS**, mental health challenges faced by Black and Brown girls, including depression, anxiety, and physical illnesses, are of utmost concern and require proactive measures to address the specific needs of Black and Brown girls; and

**WHEREAS**, by declaring Black and Brown Girls Wellness Day, we affirm our support for the resilience and strength of these young women and girls, while also raising awareness about the unique health challenges they face; and

**WHEREAS**, this day provides an opportunity to promote mental health, wellness, and self-care practices tailored to the needs of Black and Brown girls, fostering collaboration among local organizations and community leaders to ensure ongoing support and services; and

**WHEREAS**, prioritizing the well-being of Black and Brown girls is essential for building a healthier, more equitable future for all residents of Pima County; and

**WHEREAS**, this day provides an opportunity to promote mental health, wellness, and self-care practices tailored to the needs of Black and Brown girls, fostering collaboration among local organizations and community leaders to ensure ongoing support and services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims Friday, May 17, 2024, to be:
