## **NEW BUSINESS**

Proclamation stating that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaim the month of August as Drowning Impact Awareness Month.

# PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, Arizona's future prosperity depends on the long-term health, safety and well-being of the nearly 2 million children and teens in our state; and

**WHEREAS**, drowning is a leading cause of injury and death for children and teens in Arizona, affecting not only the victims, but also families, emergency personnel and our society as a whole; and

**WHEREAS**, child drownings are nearly 100% preventable; and

**WHEREAS**, research-proven strategies — including constant and capable supervision; restricting access to water; use of life jackets; swimming lessons for adults and children; and rapid emergency response, including CPR — can save lives; and

**WHEREAS**, awareness of the problem is just the first step and evidence-based programs to bring these strategies to families is the best way to save lives; and

**WHEREAS**, during the month of August, the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Arizona, in collaboration with state and local governments, community organizations and private citizens, will be engaging communities throughout Arizona in a coordinated and comprehensive response.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of August 2023 to be:

## **“DROWNING IMPACT AWARENESS MONTH”**

and urges all communities and citizens of Arizona to participate in efforts to reduce drowning risks, strengthen families, and protect children and teens.
