6. Green Valley Council, Inc., d.b.a. Green Valley Council, Amendment No. 1, to provide for Green Valley Council services, extend contract term to 12/31/22 and amend contractual language, Health (27.1%), DOT (25.7%), RWRD (17.1%), DSD (8.6%), RFCD Tax Levy (8.6%) and DEQ (12.9%) Funds, contract amount \$87,500.00 (CT-PW-21-202)

The Pima County Board of Supervisors very generously spends our tax dollars. Coming out of covid it might be time to think about how we can "reset" our counties financial goal with savings, rather than spending, in mind.

Specifically, the Green Valley Council grant amount keeps sliding up and should be re-evaluated downward or, better yet, eliminated. This quasi-government organization is nothing more than a duplicate effort, a middleman which dilutes the message to the county department responsible for whatever issue is involved. County residents should deal directly with the county department involved.

Additionally the Green Valley Council does NOT provide services to those Green Valley residents who do not contribute to them via HOA funds - and allows no way for non-HOA areas to "opt in". In other words - they discriminate!
