Declaring the month of September 2023 to be "Falls Prevention Awareness Month."

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, falling is not an inevitable effect of aging; and

WHEREAS, slips and falls are the leading cause of injury-related deaths among Americans 65 years of age and older; and

WHEREAS, Pima County had 260 fall-related deaths in 2022, 242 of which involved older adults; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of unintentional falls — even excluding expenses for physician care, EMS services, rehabilitation or long-term disability — exceeds \$3 billion a year; and

WHEREAS, nonfatal falls can lead to the loss of mobility and functional independence; and

WHEREAS, older Arizonans at risk of falling demonstrably benefit from fall-prevention programs that can teach them specific strategies to improve mobility and stability.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of September 2023 to be:

"FALLS PREVENTION AWARENESS MONTH"

and urges older adults, family members, caregivers, health-care providers, regional medical centers, fire personnel, first-responders, law enforcement officers and community partners to join the Southern Regional Chapter of the Arizona Falls Prevention Coalition and routinely assess older adults, including our veterans and those with disabilities, for fall risks while implementing strategies that improve mobility and stability to reduce falls.
