We have spoken with a number of others who reside here and am certain that the neighborhood overwhelmingly supports retaining the present usage including the horse racing (as opposed to having more soccer fields).

It is disturbing to read today's article in the paper and see your comments. The county is proposing to spend huge sums to build a "space port" for a private enterprise that may or may not succeed. I am a retired real estate attorney and know first hand that any time one takes back special purpose real estate, the liquidation value is almost always much less than what was invested when projections were positive. With the Rillito Foundation, the County has a charitable entity as a contract party that is capable of raising money from the events and from donations. I understand it is willing to pay the County for use of the facility well beyond what the soccer people are willing to pay. The cost of building and maintaining soccer fields is not

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insubstantial. The Foundation could be given a longer term contract that will help with fund raising and the County could benefit from the Foundation's success that would follow.

This is to request that the interests of those who live in the neighborhood be considered. We want the mixed use plan including the horse racing. We would like to see our County do the right thing. **Please represent our interests too!**
