Re: Proposed Agenda Item for Board of Supervisors Meeting April 14, 2015, Consent Calendar–
Intergovernmental Agreement with the Arizona Department of Health Services (#14-071222) for
Sexually Transmitted Disease Services, Amendment 1 (GTAM 15*53)

Introduction

Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs) are a significant health challenge facing the Nation. CDC estimates that nearly 20 million new STDs occur every year in this country, half among young people ages 15-24. For 2013, Pima County accounted for a significant proportion of Arizona's cases of sexually transmitted infection: gonorrhea (14%); chlamydia (17%); and primary and secondary syphilis (19%). For 2014, Pima County showed a small increase in gonorrhea and chlamydia cases but almost a three-fold increase in primary and secondary syphilis cases. The Health Department has a statutory obligation to investigate infectious or contagious diseases and adopt measures to prevent the spread of disease as referenced in ARS §36-624.

Discussion

The Health Department provides screening and treatment for individuals infected with or at risk for sexually transmitted infection, as well as investigation and follow up for their partners. As part of our core mission and in collaboration with a myriad of community partners, we also perform educational outreach to at risk individuals and communities, provide and strengthen linkages with local health care providers and develop and disseminate health promotion content.


The Arizona Department of Health Services and the Pima County Health Department entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for a five year term, beginning January 1, 2014 for STD prevention and control in Pima County. The initial annual allocation of these funds was \$101,596.00. Amendment 1 increases funding by \$20,478.00 to \$122,074.00. This funding supports additional personnel resources to assist with the identification of HIV-syphilis and HIV-gonorrhea co-infected clients, their partners, and other high risk populations that would benefit from STD screening, and HIV positive clients needing linkage to appropriate care.


Financial Impact
