I keep my swamp coolers as I am a low income senior homeowner. At income tax time the state of Arizona sends me \$25. I qualify for Homeowner Protection reduction on my property tax. Unfortunately, I do not seem to qualify for any help on my water/refuse/whatever bill.

I maintain my pool and share it with many other seniors who welcome its therapeutic value but will not go to public pools to swim for fear of health issues and shame for body image.

Hoping you will find a way to make the proposed sewer rate increase really related to sewer use.
