Requested Board Meeting Date: September 4, 2018

Title: Cancellation of Why Domestic Water Improvement District Election (Revised)

Introduction/Background:

A.R.S. 16-410 allows that if the number of persons who file nomination petitions plus the number of persons who file write-in affidavits is less than or equal to the number of positions to be filled for a water district election, the Board of Supervisors may cancel the election and appoint the person or persons to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated.

Discussion:

The Why Domestic Water Improvement District has three positions on the Board of Directors to be filled at the November 6, 2018 General Election. Three or fewer candidates have filed nomination petitions or write-in affidavits for these positions.

Conclusion:

If the Board cancels the election, the Why Domestic Water Improvement District will not incur the expense of conducting an uncontested election. A candidate who has filed nomination petitions or a write-in affidavit for a position on the Board of Directors will be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and will have the same powers and duties as if elected. If no nomination petitions or write-in affidavits have been filed, the position will be deemed vacant.

Recommendation:

Recommend canceling the uncontested Why Domestic Water Improvement District Election for the November 6, 2018 General Election.
