I only became aware of this in June thanks to my being a precinct committeeman and my party that notified me asking if I had resigned my position. The party had initially followed up with the Recorder's office but was assured that I was, in fact, deceased.

I had to make 3 trips on a very hot day in June to the various levels of jurisdictions to clear the matter and have my voter registration restored.

Thanks to the staff in Rex Scott's office and the Deputy County Recorder and subsequently the elections office, with only a couple days to spare due to an upcoming vote of the board of supervisors to replace me, I was able to retain my position.

I implore you especially in these times to not contract out the sacred duties of elections data to a private person no matter how good you think they are. They shouldn't be entrusted to fulfill your sacred duties as elected officials.
