PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Audrey Jimenez is a Sunnyside High School Blue Devil; and

WHEREAS, Audrey Jimenez won the Arizona state title for wrestling in the girl's division her freshman, sophomore, and junior years; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, and 2023 the wrestler won a silver medal in the 110 lb. weight category at the U20 World Championships; and

WHEREAS, USA Wrestling, FloWrestling, and the National Wrestling Hall of Fame and Museum have rated Sunnyside Class of 2024 standout Audrey Jimenez as the nation's number one pound-for-pound female wrestler in May 2023 for grades 8-12 in 2022-23; and

WHEREAS, Audrey Jimenez appealed with the Arizona Interscholastic Association to compete against boys this wrestling season; and

WHEREAS, Audrey Jimenez made history in 2024 as the first woman to win a high school wrestling state title in Arizona in the 56-year-old Peoria Tournament of Champions; and

WHEREAS, Audrey Jimenez is an inspiration to her community, representing her community through her technical prowess, strength, and resilience.
