Introduction/Background:

Events for Everyone, LLC has requested the temporary closure of portions of Snyder Road between Harrison Road/Bowes Road and Melpomene Way for the Everyone Runs Veterans Day Half Marathon and 5K Walk on Sunday, November 8, 2015 from 7:10 A.M. to 7:45 A.M.

Discussion:

As a result of the Pima County Traffic Engineering Division's traffic control plan review, this temporary road closure is recommended to enhance the safety of the event by reducing potential vehicular conflicts.

Conclusion:

For the safety and enjoyment of this event, it is recommended to temporarily close a portion of Snyder Road between Harrison Road/Bowes Road and Melpomene Way to allow the Everyone Runs Veterans Day Half Marathon and 5K Walk event.
