Roadway establishment Proceeding No. 3018 Regarding the Relocation of Hughes Access Road and the Development of the Aerospace Parkway

This letter is on behalf of the DM50 comprised of over 100 Business and Civic leaders in Pima County. While we focus primarily on supporting the mission and Airmen of Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, we are also supportive of any community action that fosters the overall betterment of the military and defense industry in Pima County. Therefore, we are highly supportive of the establishment and relocation of Hughes access Road and the initiation of the Aerospace Parkway.

Relocation of Hughes Access Road is critical to the continued presence and expansion of Raytheon.
