Dear Pima County Board Supervisors,

Kindly allow me to express my support of Supervisor Scott's proposed amendment to Section K.3 of the Pima County Board of Supervisors Rules and Regulations pertaining to resident comments on matters pending before the Board.

Even when an agenda item has significant public interest such that verbal remarks by any affected or aggrieved resident requires for each resident to limit their verbal presentation to two minutes (20 or more residents notify the clerk of their interest in verbally addressing the Board), there is simply no scenario by which any such affected or aggrieved resident could not readily express their concerns in the course of two minutes.

To not restrict public commentaries in some such fashion, the Board in fact grants a greater and frankly unfair advantage to residents who wish to expend precious time commenting in a discombobulated manner that is neither properly focused nor designed to much of anything other than to take an inordinate amount of time so as to potentially deny other residents with even the opportunity to make comment.

Without setting time limits for affected residents to equally address the Board before action is taken on a given matter, Pima County does a disservice to residents who may be unable to even address the Board when others view their time at the microphone as an almost filibuster strategy.


Dear Chair Grijalva and Members of the Board:

I write in support of the amendment to the Pima County Board of Supervisors (“Board”) Rules and Regulations (the “Rules”) to add time limits to Call to the Public. Allowing County residents to address the Board is an important part of each meeting, as it provides a direct conduit of ideas and criticisms to flow from the represented to their representatives. But recent Board meetings show that these proposed Rules changes are overdue. Two-plus hours of Call to the Public takes away from critical Board time needed to discuss the pertinent business of the County and the public. These meetings also show to outsiders how our community governs itself, and the recent meetings do not show Pima County in a good light.

What is most surprising about this proposed amendment is that it is not already part of the Rules. Numerous governing bodies in the region have a two- or three-minute time limit on Call to the Public speakers. Providing a speaker up to three minutes is ample time to convey an idea, a criticism, or a complaint that should be addressed by the County. Nothing in this time limit will prevent those items needing more attention to be put on future agendas for full deliberation or be referred to County staff to resolve or address.

Some may say that free speech must always be protected, and I agree with that 100 percent. Our First Amendment caselaw is clear that free speech can have reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions. I urge you to adopt this Rule change because it is a reasonable limitation that will provide everyone a chance to speak at a Board meeting and allow the Board the time it needs to conduct the County’s business.
