Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:


- Provide a written model to facilitate the matching of an intern preparing to enter a post-secondary education/work experience pathway with an employer/mentor.
- The expectation is that each participant will be matched with a seasoned employer for at least one year.

Public Benefit: Assist in the economic development of Pima County by helping to develop a trained and productive labor force that meets employer needs.

Metrics available to Measure Performance:

- Report the outcome of students who received mentoring from industry professionals and results of the mentoring relationships.
- Serve sixty (60) youth in mentor training.
