Two points:

1. I wholeheartedly and vociferously support the effort to *prevent* an I-11 route through the stunning Avra Valley. However, a resolution, while a valuable display, is only a start: Supervisor Bronson, I ask you to exhaust every possible legal avenue available to you to fight this possible route *and to win that fight*, and I exhort each of the supervisors of the remaining four districts to give you every possible measure of support. Routing I-11 through District 3 would be a tragedy and a travesty, and an indictment of the entire county. This matters to more than just District 3, this matters to all of us.

3. The fact that this body is again deliberating a mandate to inject employees of the county with an experimental drug is beyond shameful: It is unjust, it is inhumane, and it is utterly unconscionable. To quote the University of Pennsylvania: "No large trials of any mRNA vaccine have been completed yet. The only evidence on safety of mRNA vaccines comes from small phase I and phase II trials of SARS-CoV-2 vaccines, with follow-up typically less than two months." In fact, only one of many prospective mRNA therapies in fifteen years of research and development prior to the Covid crisis has made it past Phase II. Mandating these vaccines for your employees is mandatory participation in a medical experiment, and is beyond unethical.
