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Dear County Board,

I am writing regarding Agenda Item #29, the Expenditure Limit Adjustment.

After reviewing the available information, I have several concerns regarding this significant and unusual proposal. These limits have successfully maintained county solvency for the past 45 years. I would like to understand why this has suddenly become an urgent issue. Specifically, has the county received a windfall of funds it cannot spend, or is this the result of long-term budgetary issues?

Requesting nearly double the current limit is a substantial change. Given that this has not been raised as a critical concern until now, I ask that the Board delay this decision until the 2028 election. This would allow citizens sufficient time to review the financial data and receive answers to these important questions.
