WHEREAS, Dr. V continues to serve the mariachi community after his retirement through volunteering with mariachi programs, collecting discarded instruments, repairing them, and then donating them to neighboring music programs; and

WHEREAS, Alfredo’s children, grandchildren and great grandchildren join the thousands of former students that continue to be part of Dr. V’s legacy by promoting and performing mariachi music; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Alfredo Valenzuela is a treasure to the Tucson community who has lived his life in service to others;
