Chair Bronson & Board of Supervisors,

I saw on your agenda that there is an item to discuss canceling funding for the Arizona Bowl and I just want to offer my comments on this issue.

I have no skin in the game on this. I am not on the AZ Bowl committee, I haven't even been to one of the bowl games. However, I have been to some of the events downtown to celebrate this event and so have my friends and family from out of town.

The Arizona Bowl game is an opportunity for people to come to Tucson, spend money and celebrate the culture we have here.
