ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This Intergovernmental Agreement between Pima County and the Arizona Superior Court, on behalf of the Pima County Juvenile Court, provides for Pima County administration and oversight of contracted healthcare services at the Pima County Juvenile Detention Center. This IGA gives Pima County the Court's authority to contract for said healthcare services and provides for the Court to transfer certain revenues to the County to help offset the cost of providing services.

Amendment two (2) is to extend the IGA for an additional year and to replace the Department of Institutional Health (which will terminate June 30, 2013) with the Office of Medical Services' Department as the County department overseeing implementation of the Agreement.
