Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Pima County and The City of Tucson

For the

Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program FY 2016 Local Solicitation

WHEREAS, The City and County have received notice of a \$373,058.00 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA); and

WHEREAS, the City and County, disparate jurisdictions, wish to submit a joint application for JAG funds to the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice requires disparate jurisdictions to enter into an MOU indicating which jurisdiction will serve as the applicant/fiscal for the joint JAG fund; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to act as the applicant/fiscal agent and provide the County \$177,203.00 from the JAG award for use in eligible programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tucson, Tucson Police Department (TPD), as the assigned Fiduciary, will budget 5% (\$18,653.00) of the total award and split equally between the County and the City for allowable administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to allocate \$177,202.00 from the JAG award for its use in eligible programs; and

WHEREAS, it is in the County's and City's best interests to reallocate their portion of the JAG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the City and County agree as follows:

Section 1.

The above recitals are incorporated herein as if set out verbatim.

Section 2.

The parties shall cooperate in the submission of an application for JAG funds. City shall act as the applicant/fiscal agent for the grant on behalf of all parties, and shall pay the County a total of \$177,203.00, after such funds are received by the City, to be used by the County for programs eligible for the use of JAG funds pursuant to applicable U.S. Department of Justice rules and regulations. The parties will complete an Intergovernmental Agreement detailing financial reporting requirements prior to using JAG funds.

Section 3.

By entering into this MOU, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out to herein. This MOU shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.

Section 4.

This MOU is subject to cancellation for conflict of interest as provided in A.R.S. ss38-511.
