Dear Ms. Miller: I am writing to show my concerns about the Fenster-Sabino Recovery issue coming before you next week. Sabino Recovery LLC plans to locate a residential behavior health facility in part of the Fenster School property on Ocotillo Dr. I live immediately adjacent to said property and want to make sure that the Planning Commission's conditions for occupancy are preserved. These are: no court ordered cases will be treated there; no sex offender cases will be treated there; and no felony cases will be treated there.

**Comments** Other facilities of this type are not placed so close to residential properties. Our homes are only 500 feet from the buildings that will be used. I would request that you and the other Board Members specify that Sabino Recovery will provide physical barriers such as fencing or gates or locked buildings or 24 hour security personnel to make sure that the residents remain on the premises. I am calling upon you to preserve our quiet safe neighborhoods that are so close to this planned residential behavior health facility. Thank you for your consideration
