ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This Intergovernmental Agreement between Pima County and the Arizona Superior Court, on behalf of the Pima County Juvenile Court, provides for Pima County administration and oversight of contracted healthcare services at the Pima County Juvenile Detention Center. This IGA gives Pima County the Court's authority to contract for said healthcare services and provides for the Court to transfer certain revenues to the County to help offset the cost of providing services.

Amendment three (3) is to extend the IGA for an additional year and to make a couple of minor corrections/updates.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

DELETE from ARTICLE II – SCOPE, 2.3 Joint Duties specific to this Agreement, Section B. and replace with the following:

B. The County Chief Correctional Medical Officer and Behavioral Health Administrator and other County Medical and Health Services personnel as required will meet with the Presiding Judge of the Juvenile Court or designee and the Court Administrator or designee at least quarterly to review findings, status of health care operations and issues of interest regarding Contractor services;

The effective date of this Amendment shall be June 30, 2014.

All other provisions of the Contract, not specifically changed by this Amendment, shall remain in effect and be binding upon the parties.
