Chairwoman Bronson and Supervisors:

- 1. On or about November 15, 2022, an election ballot box inspector contacted me to report what they felt was a situation that involved further investigation and pertaining to the November 8, 2022, election. As this individual was inspecting ballot box VC 123, they became aware the ballot box was empty of any votes yet the county's election report detailed 745 votes had been cast at this center. Thus, I filed the following public records request to being my investigation of this alleged action.
- 2. On or about November 27, 2022, I made the following Public Records Request to Pima County: **PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST:**

Please provide copies of any and all inspection reports, statements, verified statements, and/or other written documents pertaining to Pima County Vote Center 123 (HIS Presence Church Arizona) general election ballot box completed by the election inspectors [inspector name 1] and/or [inspector name 2] and/or other persons on or about November 8, 2022, and filed with Pima County. Said inspection report and/or other named document should include but not be limited to information regarding the condition of said ballot box received, identification information pertaining to said ballot box tags, time ballot box received by the Elections Office, as well as any notations regarding the contents of said ballot box.

- 3. On or about November 29, 2022, I received a response and supporting documentation from the County in response to my public records request (see attached files). What I found interesting is that the information provided on Inspection Board Log Metal Ballot Box form matched identical to what had been reported to me by an election inspector responsible for inspecting ballot box VC 123, as well as signing said log certifying the following:
 - a. Are the voted ballots in the metal ballot box? Response: NO
 - b. Is the Yellow Ballot Report in the Metal Ballot Box? Response: NO
 - c. In the section "please make a list of all items in the Metal Ballot Box that were included erroneously," the inspector wrote: "Seal # are not matching / no ballot, no yellow ballot report."
- 4. Thus, my question is this: if there were no ballots in the box during the inspection, how is that the Pima County Vote Center Accessibility report dated November 8, 2022 General Election, recorded 745 Ballots cast for this Vote Center 123?
- 5. I understand there is an accompanying document in the public records request loaded with marginalia comments that allude to the fact the box was returned to the center at or about 9:12 pm and returned at 10:27 pm is this even possible? And, if so, where is the ballot box inspection report for this box from the

first time the box was delivered to the election night official? There was no document provided for this "delivery of the box" to the vote center. One of the election inspection receipt docs states at the bottom of the form that the box "arrived without ipad and cradle point" and "sent back to pull station to retrieve missing items." Is this a customary process to return ballot boxes to centers only to have them returned with double metal tags – two of which do not match the detail log? Also, I would presume there would have been documents detailing the chain of custody of the ballot box once it presumably left the election center and was subsequently returned to the vote center, but it did not appear to be provided in the public records request. Would there be two separate chain of custody reports: one for being returned to the voting center, and once for being returned to the election office?

6. I suggest the board have someone review these documents and outline exactly what happened here and provide substantial proof of the chain of custody. Then, report back to you and the taxpayers. I have never seen nor heard of a ballot box being returned to a voting center for these items or for these reasons. I am treating this as if it were a research project and want to verify the information and facts to complete the analysis of the situation. This is not election denying, but rather election researching based on the documents provided to me by the county and subsequently substantiated by one of the election inspection workers.
