

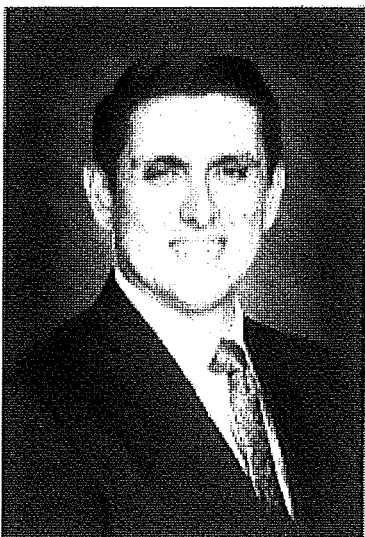



I firmly believe there is no reason to complicate this process by adding the proposed procedures.
