Unfortunately, these assistance programs do not ensure the applicant/recipients are U.S. Citizens and the definition of "qualified immigrant" is defined as lawful permanent residents, or LPRs (people with green cards) refugees, people granted asylum or withholding of deportation/removal, and conditional entrants which covers just about anyone crossing the U.S./Mexican borders today. The BoS needs to provide the metrics from 2020 to today showing the number of unique recipients for each individual assistance program indicating whether they were U.S. Citizens or "Qualified Immigrants" along with the dollar amount awarded.
