Racial and Ethnic Approaches to Community Health (REACH) Pima Partnership

### \*Purpose:

The REACH Pima Partnership brings together entities with a history of successful collaboration on health and wellness issues among American Indian (AI) and Mexican-American (MA) populations throughout Pima County. The partners will build on existing Community Action Coalitions to develop and implement culturally and socioeconomically tailored interventions that specifically engage MA and AI communities in Pima County. The project aims to improve health, prevent chronic diseases, and reduce health disparities among our population at the highest risk/burden of chronic diseases including hypertension, heart disease, Type 2 diabetes, and obesity.

This Notice of Award for budget period from 09/30/2020 through 09/29/2021 is being processed as Amendment #4. The Notice of Award adds \$606,334.00 in supplemental funds for the purpose of promoting immunization to target groups. Please see attached email for confirmation of the amount being added with this Award. No signature is required. Indirect costs in the amount of 10% of Direct Costs are included in the budget.

#### \*Procurement Method:

This Grant is a non-procurement contract and not subject to Procurement rules.

#### \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

- Work with communities to identify and address drivers of vaccine hesitancy, identify influential community
  messengers and partners, and develop community-acceptable approaches for improving vaccination availability,
  accessibility, and confidence
- Educate and empower trusted voices in the community to support vaccine education and delivery through educational media and events.
- Increase vaccination opportunities by building partnerships between vaccination providers and the community to increase the number, range, and diversity of opportunities for vaccination.

#### \*Public Benefit:

Adult vaccination coverage in the U.S. remains low and significant racial and ethnic disparities exist. The groups experiencing disparities are also disproportionately affected by COVID, at risk for serious illness from COVID, and/or at high risk for complications from illnesses associated with the flu. Given the co-circulation of COVID and the flu viruses, it is important now more than ever to have as many people in Pima County equitably vaccinated against the COVID and flu viruses. This effort will also help prevent overcrowding in hospitals, reduce the spread of respiratory illnesses, increase confidence and opportunities for public access to vaccinations and messaging, and support REACH program work to continue to address health disparities associated with other conditions at the community level.

#### \*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

The work plan submitted as part of the proposal includes outcome measures such as # of community-level messengers trained, # trained tribal community spokespersons, materials produced and distributed trusted messengers, schools and other partners, # of flu and COVID vaccination events held and # of partnerships formed.



Importance: High

The Pima County Health Department received the attached NOA via Grant Solutions today. I am seeking clarification on what is being added with this NOA. The \$1,559,188 on line 25 appears to be the total of the following:

One year annual funding: \$762,685

Amendment #4: \$606,334 (new supplemental funding for vaccination)

Amendment #3: \$190,169 (this funding was already received, also for vaccination)

My question is about the one year annual funding. Is that for Year 3 or Year 4 (9/30/21-9/29/22)? Lines 23 and 25 say, "total amount of federal funds obligated (or approved) this budget period". This budget period is indicated to be 9/30/20-9/29/21. The NOA for Year 3 funding is dated 6/29/2020, which is before "this budget period". That would indicate to me that this annual funding is new funding for Year 4, but I am not sure. The previous NOA form said, "amount of financial assistance this action". That was much more clear, instead of including funding that was previously awarded. To further complicate matters, #27, total amount of funding, just says, "not available". Otherwise, it would have been clear whether the total included 3 or 4 years of regular funding.

Pima County requires that our Board of Supervisors approve all grant funds. They have already approved annual funding for Year 3 and the \$190,169 for vaccination. I am seeking clarification on how much of this NOA is new funding so I can get that amount approved by the Board.


