Proclamation and Presentation to the Sunnyside Little League Softball Team.

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Little League Softball was created in 1974 so that girls could participate in Little League, and has grown to 25,000 teams and 360,000 players worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Sunnyside Little League has long called Mission Manor Park its home and has given hundreds of girls ages 12 and under an opportunity to grow strong, compete and win; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2013, Sunnyside Little League won the District 12 Little League Softball Championship in Pima County; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2013, Sunnyside Little League won the Arizona State Little League Softball Championship; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2013, Sunnyside Little League became first team from Arizona since San Xavier of Tucson in 2002 to capture the Western Regional title and advance to the Little League Softball World Series; and

WHEREAS, from August 10 to August 14, 2013, Sunnyside Little League won five straight games in the Little League Softball World Series; and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2013, the Sunnyside Little League became the first Little League Softball World Series champion from the West Region in 23 years; and

WHEREAS, the Sunnyside Little League became Arizona's first-ever Little League Softball World Series champion; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby invites all residents of Pima County to congratulate and celebrate the accomplishments of
