PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the construction industry is one of the largest industries in the United States, employing more than five million workers; and

WHEREAS, construction craft professionals play a critical role in Pima County's economy and in the development of the local workforce; and

WHEREAS, many local construction and engineering companies, utilities, workforce agencies and educational institutions – including the University of Arizona, Pima Community College and Joint Technical Education District – are organizing the Fourth Annual Southern Arizona Construction Career Days on October 25 and 26 at the Tucson Rodeo Grounds where high school students will learn that education and training can lead to good-paying jobs with advancement opportunities; and

WHEREAS, more than 1,000 high-school students from across Southern Arizona are expected to participate in hands-on demonstrations, to operate heavy equipment and to visit with local construction industry professionals at career and college booths; and

WHEREAS, recognition of this event will increase public awareness and appreciation of the local collaboration and the potential benefits to our community's young people, our economy and our way of life.
