Title: Co14-14-02 Major Streets and Scenic Routes Plan (MSSRP) Plan Amendments, Pima Prospers

#### Introduction/Background:

This ordinance updates the MSSRP as approved by the Board of Supervisors on May 19, 2015 as part of Pima Prospers, the Comprehensive Plan Update.

#### Discussion:

The purpose of the MSSRP is primarily to reserve roadway right-of-way for future widening and improvements if needed. The changes recommended by staff reflect updated population projections, growth planning, and roadway planning needs. In many cases, the right-of-way designation has been reduced and in a few cases major streets have been deleted. Exhibits A and B are presented in 11 x 17 and 8 1/2 x 11 formats for the Board's convenience. The 11 x 17 format is to be attached to the Ordinance.

#### Conclusion:

This ordinance ratifies the action taken by the Board of Supervisors on May 19, 2015. The changes include separating the MSSRP into two maps (Major Streets Plan and Scenic Routes Plan), adding eleven new major streets, increasing the future right-of-way designation for four major streets, deleting 53 major streets, reducing the future right-of-way designation for 105 major streets, and changing 20 scenic, major streets to scenic routes only (not major). The changes also include a new roadway classification system to depict major streets and their future right-of-way designation on the map.

#### THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:



- 3. On May 19, 2015 the Pima County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to adopt proposed changes to the Major Streets and Scenic Routes Plan in conjunction with Pima Prospers, the Pima County Comprehensive Plan Update, per staff recommendation, with amendments, to replace the previous Major Streets and Scenic Routes Plan. The changes include the creation of two maps, the Major Streets Plan, and the Scenic Routes Plan.
