At this time the two areas that have been in contention are the parking lot of the San Ignacio golf course; and A maintenance building near the 15th hole of the golf course. High winds disallowed the

Plan to see how the tower would affect the views of the homeowners. A drone was flown in place of the balloon - it could hardly be seen. In my humble opinion, this had no value and does not answer the question.

I go back to my original opinion, which is that it does not belong in the parking lot of the golf course! There are homes so close that those homeowners will both hear and see it. This is the most inappropriate site of any that has been mentioned.

The fact that everyone entering San Ignacio Heights subdivision will come upon the cell tower immediately, is a detriment, especially for prospective buyers.

I understand the need for cell towers and am not against them - the site at the maintenance shed would be more appropriate; or move it to the other side of the parking lot on Camino del Sol and then people would not be turning on to Desert Jewel Dr.

I respectfully ask you to vote for the maintenance shed area or the Camino del Sol Area.
