**Community Law Enforcement Partnership Commission Appointment of
Tohono O'odham Nation, Department of Public Safety Director**

Background

On February 20, 2018, the Board of Supervisors accepted the Operation Stonegarden (OPSG) grant for this fiscal year subject to five conditions. One of those conditions was the creation of a Board of Supervisors, Community Law Enforcement Partnership Commission (Commission). Thus far, eight of the 10 voting members of the Commission have been selected and the Pima County Sheriff will also sit on the Commission as an ex-officio, nonvoting member.

In a recent meeting with the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, it was discussed and mutually agreed that the Nation should have a representative on the Commission.

Recommendation

I recommend that the Board of Supervisors appoint the Tohono O'odham Nation, Department Public Safety Director, to the Community Law Enforcement Partnership Commission, as an ex-officio, nonvoting member.
