RE: Explanation of Difference in Pima County Voter Registration Numbers

The total number of registered voters used to canvass the November 2022 election include inactive and national inactive voters. The pre-election registered voter totals provided to the Secretary of State only include active voters. Pima County has 62,826 inactive voters and 2,361 national inactive voters. Inactive voters are eligible to vote on Election Day, and any inactive voters who vote are included in the turnout.

The registered voter number initially submitted to the Secretary of State is 639,885. However, the registered voter number used to canvass the election is 705,072. The increase reflects the 65,187 inactive voters in Pima County.
