WHEREAS, “Mitzvah Day” is an annual day of social action in communities across the nation where all people (regardless of faith preference) are invited to volunteer to help others; and

WHEREAS, the first Mitzvah Day in the Green Valley, Sahuarita and Amado area took place in 2014 where more than 150 volunteers from approximately 10 faith-based organizations participated; and

WHEREAS, beneficiaries included food banks, a youth center, a library, the Alzheimer’s Association, White Elephant, schools and Friends in Deed; and

WHEREAS, Mitzvah Days 2015 will be held on Friday morning, November 6th and Sunday afternoon, November 8th;
