## **PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS**, the National Weather Service provides severe weather warnings to the citizens of Pima County 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Weather Service works in close cooperation with the local media outlets to provide critical weather information as quickly as possible to protect lives and property from the hazards of severe weather; and

**WHEREAS**, due to its desert location, Pima County frequently experiences thunderstorm-generated wind, dust, electrical storms, and dangerous flash floods during the summer monsoon season, all of which pose a considerable threat to the community; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the National Weather Service is to work with its partners, the Pima County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, Pima County Regional Flood Control District, the U.S. Forest Service, City of Tucson Department of Transportation – Stormwater Management Section, Town of Marana Stormwater Management, American Red Cross Southern Arizona Chapter, Tohono O'odham Nation Office of Emergency Management, Tucson Electric Power, Tucson Fire Department, Northwest Fire Department, Rural/Metro Fire Department, Vaisala, Friends of Sabino Canyon, and the Southern Arizona Rescue Association, as well as Tucson News Now, KGUN-TV, KVOA-TV, and the Arizona Daily Star, to inform the community of what to do when severe weather associated with the summer monsoon season strikes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pima County Board of Supervisors, does hereby proclaim the week of June 9 through 14, 2013 to be
