Along with the many outstanding questions I would like to know why the letter from Ms. Hargrove to the Secretary of State originally did not include "inactive" voters. Either a voter is registered or not, there is no in-between. If the inactive voter names were intended to be removed from the voter rolls then why weren't they removed? A more important question is how many of those 65,187 "inactive" actually voters show on election records as having participated in the 2022 General Election?
