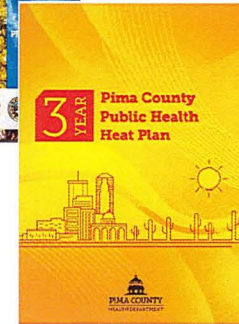
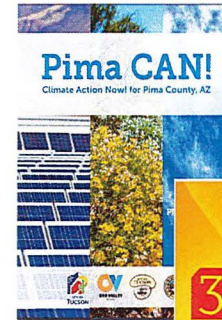
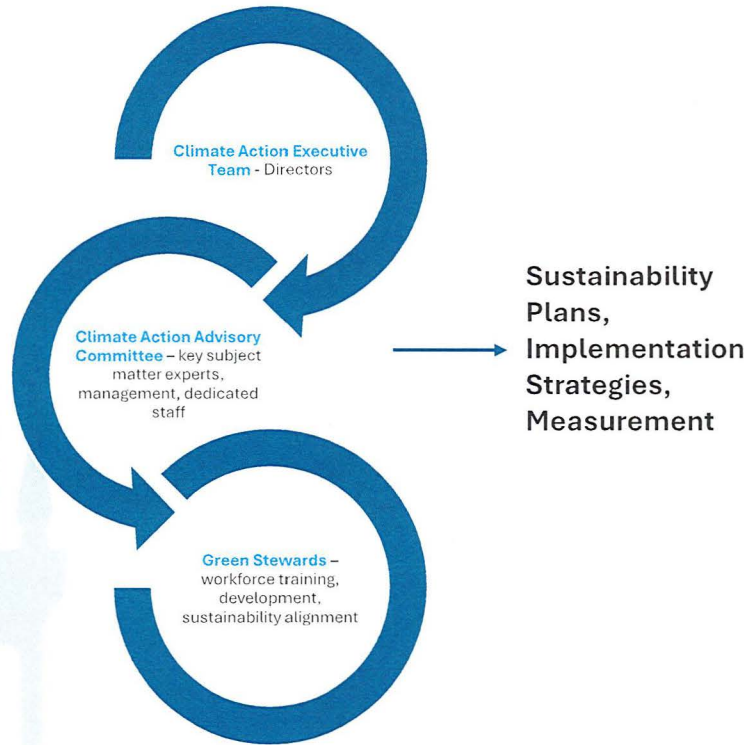

- Integration of Planning Efforts (Pima Prospers, CIP, Infrastructure)

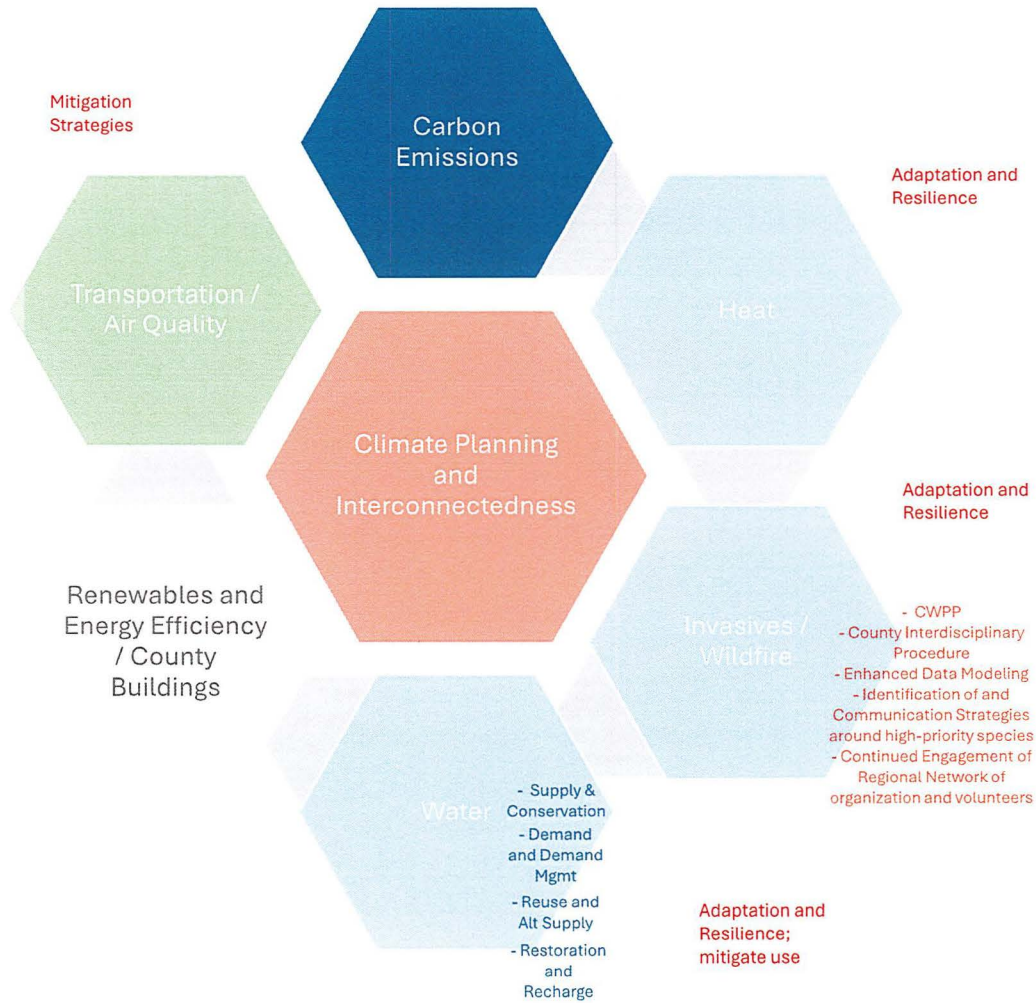
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- Malleable and Scalable Project Development (data driven, operational capacity, and evaluative design)
