Greetings,

Thank you for asking the recorder and the elections director to come to today's meeting and answer questions regarding what we uncovered from Pima County's public records forms.

Most of the violations we uncovered stem from Early voting which is run by the recorders' office. I expected no less than Gabriella Cazares-Kelly would not show because of the over-whelming amount of evidence we uncovered. That and the fact, that she herself dropped off ballots that arrived on election day, but she did not bother to have counted until ONE WEEK AFTER the election, if at all. She is incompetent and does follow the law.

Thanks to Ms. Hargrove for coming. We would have liked to ask questions and get those answered. Unfortunately, our mistrust in the election process or elections systems have not resolved.

The FORM that the Elections Director displayed on screen, makes my case. Recall, I had said in my 3-minutes that we the people are held to a higher standard than the county staff.

That form is being filled out by election workers (that's the public) at the end of election day. We have to account for every piece of equipment and every piece of paper stock and voted ballots.

It is the form that we (acting as Inspector, Marshal and Judges of Opposite parties) fill out. Pima County staff do not fill out such detailed forms. There is less accounting or precision afforded when they dole out unlimited amounts of ballot stock or pre-printed ballots during early voting. That was the case I made to you.

We the people are being held to higher standards than your staff, the "public servants."

I appreciate that Ms. Hargrove provided answers. That way, elections can make improvements of internal processes and resolve possible misconceptions. We don't trust Pima County staff. There have been rumors of ballot stuffing for more than 20 or 30 years. Therefore, although it is not required to show the live feed of the ballot vault, consider for the 2024 General Election to show the live feed to the door of the overnight storage vault of voted ballots.

You don't have to disclose its location. Thank you.
