A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA; RELATING TO PLANNING; AMENDING THE PIMA COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN LAND USE MAP FOR APPROXIMATELY 25.0 ACRES IN SECTION 5 OF TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, IN THE RINCON SOUTHEAST/SANTA RITA SUBREGION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Pima County Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map, Rincon Southeast/Santa Rita Subregion, is hereby amended to change the planned land use intensity category for approximately **25.0 acres**, as referenced in **Co7-13-02 Smith Virgil B Revocable Living Trust – S. Freeman Road Alignment Plan Amendment**, located at the east side of S. Freeman Road Alignment, approximately one-half mile south of Mary Ann Cleveland Way and one-quarter mile north of the Union Pacific Railroad, in Section 5, Township 16 South, Range 16 East, as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference, from Low Intensity Rural (LIR) to Medium Intensity Urban (MIU).

<u>Section 2</u>. The various County officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary to give effect to this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective on the date of adoption.
