PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, each year September is designated as "National Preparedness Month," in which there is a nationwide coordinated effort sponsored by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to raise awareness about the importance of emergency preparedness and to encourage every citizen to better prepare their homes, businesses, schools and communities for any type of emergency including natural disasters and potential terrorist attacks; and

WHEREAS, emergency preparedness is the responsibility of every resident of Pima County and all are urged to make preparedness a priority by investing in the preparedness of ourselves, our families, businesses, schools and communities in order reduce fatalities and economic devastation in our community and in our nation; and

WHEREAS, during the month of September, the Pima County Office of Emergency Management along with the Citizen Corps Councils in Pima County and other local, tribal, private, and volunteer agencies will engage in activities that encourage residents to take steps to make themselves and their families better prepared for disasters and emergencies of any type; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of County Supervisors hereby proclaim the month of September 2013 to be

"PREPAREDNESS MONTH"

in Pima County, and encourages citizens, businesses, schools and communities to proactively resolve to be ready for potential emergencies by taking simple steps such as organizing an emergency supply kit, making a personal preparedness plan, becoming informed about different threats, reviewing recommendations found at ready gov or listo gov, and getting involved in preparing their communities to ensure Pima County stands ready to respond to any disaster or emergency.
